

Worship Intern

Job Description

The primary responsibility of the part-time Worship Intern will be to lead the early Sunday service in a contemporary worship style. This position is directly accountable and supervised by the Senior Pastor. The candidate will possess an adaptable skill set including leadership capabilities. These leadership capabilities will enable a worship ministry to grow if, and when additional musicians and vocalists are added to this service.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Continue to grow and mature in Christ as a godly person of integrity. Possess a strong sense of calling and identity in Christ. Demonstrates leadership by discipling to those in his/her sphere of influence.
2. Proficiency in leading worship with a strong vocal ability. Capability of leading with a guitar and/or keyboard is strongly preferred.
3. Lead the Early Sunday Worship service primarily using contemporary worship music or older music with contemporary arrangements.
4. If possible, recruit and develop a worship team. Schedule vocalists for the early service. Prepare for and lead rehearsals. Consult with the Senior Pastor to coordinate the music for the Sunday services.
5. Provide timely communication of planned music titles and/or lyrics to Ministry Assistant for bulletin printing.
6. Utilize live instruments and live vocals with occasional prerecorded accompaniment if needed.
7. Work with Music Ministry Director to develop and administer an annual budget for the worship ministry in accordance with the financial policies of the church.
8. Attend staff meetings when available. Meet with the Senior Pastor as necessary.
