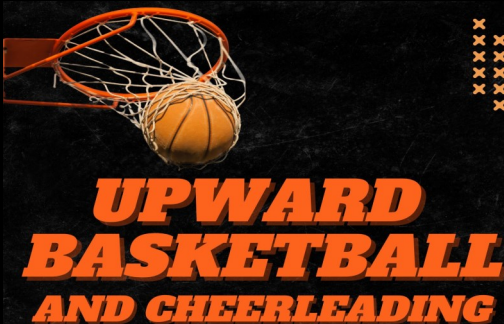
Keenagers and friends mark your calendars for Tuesday, October 28th.

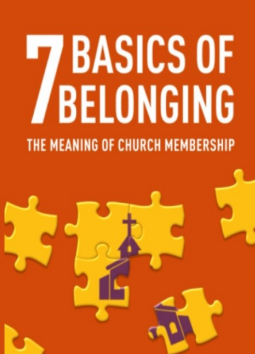
