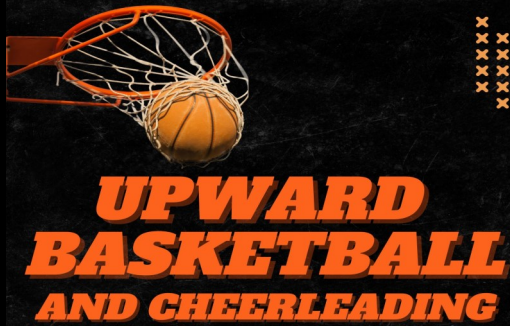
**Keenagers and friends mark your
